**SAINTS OF THE WEEK**

**Monday : St Philip Neri**

Philip Neri was born in Florence in 1515, and died in Rome in 1595. He worked among the young and the poor in Rome, and founded the Congregation of the Oratory. Known for his humour, simplicity and charity, he worked hard to reform the Church in the aftermath of the Council of Trent.

**Tuesday : St Augustine of Canterbury**

Born in Italy in the 6<sup>th</sup> Century, Augustine died at Canterbury around 605. He had been sent by St Gregory the Great to preach the Gospel to the English. Augustine evangelised the Kingdom of Kent, and is venerated by Catholics and Anglicans as the founder of the See of Canterbury.

**Saturday: The Visitation of the Blessed Virgin Mary**

The feast celebrates Mary's visit to her cousin Elizabeth as recounted in Luke's Gospel, and her example of faith in God's word.

**Mass at 1030 (T) – Deceased of the Hayes Family**

Followed by Sacrament of Reconciliation (11-12noon)
